Leadenham Junior HC

- 2007
 - Sixty nine junior players
 - Thirty seven senior players
 - Four county players
 - Two regional players
 - One England Under Sixteen Player

Results to date

- All clubs registered for accreditation.
- £163,300 awards for all grants
- £6510 additional funding sources
- 3448 people involved in additional sporting activities
- 11 clubs accredited this year



Incentives for the hardcore

- Development group grants will not be paid to clubs that are not actively working towards Club Mark
- School club links will only be made with accredited clubs
- Grant applications dependent on accreditation
