| <p>NGB deployment focus for the Community Sports Coaches, linked to the NGB player pathway and relevant development initiatives.</p> | <p>The delivery of badminton by Community Sports Coachers will be through the BAofE'S BISI programme (Badminton Into Schools Initiative). At Key Stages 1 and 2, the BISI Stages 1 and 2 develop generic physical skills using multi-skill activities with a fun base. At Key stages 3 and 4, BISI 3 and 4 provide badminton specific knowledge which is complemented by an Awards scheme. The 4 Stage BISI programme, linked to the 4 Key Stages, provides and ideal development tool for our sport.</p> <p>Club – School Links Our programmes are very strongly based on the work of School Sport Co-ordinator Partnerships. After school, clubs are linked to BAofE clubs to ensure a pathway into our club structure. Community Sports Coaches can play a vital part in establishing links between school and community by establishing the after-school clubs and working with our development network to establish links with BAofE clubs. All junior clubs will be encouraged to work through our BISI Clubmark accreditation scheme from the bronze level to gold. We see a need for a badminton Community Sports Coach to be based in every School Sports Co-ordinator Partnership.</p> |
| <p>Minimum level of NGB coaching qualification for coaches employed through the Community Sports Coach Scheme</p> | <p>Currently Coach (Part 1) which will be Level 3 of our new award scheme that is being developed to tie in with the National Coaching Certificate. Coaches will be expected to complete the relevant child Protection and Disabilities Workshops and to benefit from the professional development resources and opportunities provided by the Coaching Department.</p> |
