These would provide for the Fundamentals of Movement and the Fundamentals of Netball at this stage. These clubs would be the focus for the young leaders who are being trained within the partnership between School Sport Partnerships and England Netball to deliver High Five Netball in clubs for this age group.</p> <p>11-13 years, again providing Fundamentals in Local Coaching Centres and junior clubs to allow development into the Learning to Train phase, working towards Satellite Academy Performance standards.</p> <p>The clubs that will be targeted will have or will be working to England Netball CAPS club accreditation and be working with coaches/volunteers in these clubs, there will be more junior clubs linked to schools providing quality coaching.</p>
