<p>NGB deployment focus for the community Sports Coaches linked to the NGB player pathway and relevant development initiatives</p>	<p>Whilst acknowledging pre-seven year olds and associated generic programmes of skills development i.e. passing, catching, running development using the medium of Rugby League to facilitate the same, our expectation would be that of primarily working with 7-14 year olds taking part in multi activity.</p> <p>The Community Sports Coach will be able to deliver fundamentals and aspects of training to train programmes to other club, school and community coaches/teachers working in the identified areas within the Long Term Athlete Development Model. This, along with their ability to mentor others involved in the programme being the major focus of work.</p> <p>Community Sports Coaches should also compliment existing work being carried out by the schools sports co-ordinators' network in the area of linking schools with clubs and in the future if required and as the programme evolves, have the ability to facilitate training to staff in relation to the Rugby League Secondary Teachers Award, the Little league Primary Teachers Award, TOP Sport (Rugby League) and work with students in Key Stage 4 in the delivery of the Junior Rugby League Organisers Award and associated coaching sessions.</p> <p>By working in this way the Community Sports Coach will be strategically cascading information and appropriate coaching and mentoring programmes for the benefit of young people at a local level.</p> <p>Therefore the work of the Community Sports Coach will provide clear strategic links with school sports co-coordinators/PE co-ordinators, schools and quality assured local clubs, with a potential to further utilise nationally recognised programmes to deliver additional elements to the prescribed project for the benefit of young people at a local level.</p>
<p>Minimum level of NGB coaching qualification for coaches employed through the Community Sports Coach Scheme</p>	<p>The Community Sports Coach should be experienced, with the ability to deliver a range of programmes that facilitate the project's outcomes.</p> <p>Able to evidence and are committed to continuing professional development and qualified through the Rugby League Coach Education Programme to Senior Coach (Level 3) standard.</p>
