<p>NGB deployment focus for the Community Sports Coaches, linked to the NGB player pathway and relevant development initiatives.</p> <p>N.B This must reflect the scheme deployment parameters detailed in the attached guidance notes.</p>	<p>The aim would be to establish Community Sports Coaches within a range of key clubs throughout the country. These clubs would correspond with the clubs chosen to be integrated with the RYA 'On board' scheme which focuses on creating links with schools, sail training centres and sailing clubs. The thrust of this scheme looks to raise the numbers of people exposed to sailing and encouraging them to progress to becoming active within the sport.</p> <p>Each partnership between Local Authority and specific clubs would be suggested and agreed based on local need with individual details then developed between the partners involved.</p> <p>The NGB would look to create the training packages and continual professional development programme based on the needs of the coaches and the coaching role.</p> <p>The RYA would also see that within the club the Community Sports Coach would provide links with the regional RYA squads acting as a liaison officer for the club and talent scout for the World Class Sailing schemes.</p>
