<p><b>NGB deployment focus for the Community Sports Coaches linked to the NGB National Coaching Scheme, relevant development initiatives and reflecting the scheme deployment parameters as detailed in the guidance notes</b></p>	<p><b><u>England Squash Pathways</u></b></p> <p>National Coaching Scheme      Mini Squash – Development Player – Top Player  All based on a series of progressions from generic activity which promote the key aspects of the game – technique, tactical awareness, movement &amp; coordination and competition as well areas such as health and fitness. All levels offer a series of fun games and progressions.</p> <p>Supported with England Squash resources: Lesson Plans/Player Award Schemes/Fun Games/Modified Equipment/Coach and Teacher education</p> <p>Linked to DCMS initiative PE &amp; School Sport and Out of School Hours for Learning Youth Sport – squash specific and generic initiative Net Wall Games</p> <p>Mini Squash 5 to 11 year olds. Introduction of core skills, Talent ID &amp; Development of players.</p> <p>Development Player 9 to 16 year olds. Juniors in clubs whose progress has taken them beyond Mini Squash.</p> <p>Top Player 9 to 19 year olds. Juniors who are at County and Regional standard.</p> <p><b><u>Links and Partnerships</u></b></p> <p>The work of Community Sports Coaches should aim to add value to the work being carried out within England Squash and establish links with Charter Clubs (212), Specialist Sports Colleges, Local Authorities with School Sport Co-ordinators and County Associations with the National Coaching Scheme programme. Delivered locally by a Squash Development Officer who is managed by one of six England Squash Area Managers as a major part of their work programme.</p> <p>England Squash Charter Clubs operate to formally agreed standards with development plans that integrate programmes of Coach/Teacher education/accreditation Volunteer recruitment/training/support/recognition to link club/school/LA activity</p> <p>Schools and LAs should also provide in-service training for staff/pupils with Teachers/Leaders/CSLA Squash awards</p> <p>England Squash have also led the development of a Racket Sport group who are working collaboratively to provide an experience for teachers and pupils across the Squash, Badminton, Table Tennis and Tennis. This is supported by a newly designed Racket Sport Coach Education module – ideal for those delivering an early learning multi sport experience.</p>
<p><b>Minimum NGB coaching qualification for employed coaches</b></p>	<p>England Squash Level 1 Coach Award (only if coach is working solely on agreed Mini Squash programmes)</p> <p>England Squash Level 2 Coach Award (Incorporates National Coaching Scheme)</p>

<p><b>NGB Priority Partnership areas</b></p>	<p><b><u>National Strategic Priorities</u></b></p> <p>Clubs within the England Squash network of Chartered Clubs, where each has demonstrated appropriate provision for coaching, competition, playing programmes and duty of care.</p> <p>Priority Partnership Areas will be where a ‘Squash Development Partnership’ (SDP) is established. The membership of a SDP is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• England Squash Squash Development Officer/Area Manager (Coordinator)</li> <li>• Director of Sport/Partnership Development Manager – Specialist Sports College</li> <li>• Representative of the County Sports Partnership</li> <li>• Local Authority Sports Development Officer/Facility Manager</li> <li>• Representative of the Chartered Club</li> </ul> <p>The SDP’s aim to is to focus resources and opportunities within a 20 minute ‘drive time’ of a Specialist Sports College.</p> <p><b><u>Local Strategic Priorities</u></b> – Counties where there is an established SDP (or the process of establishing an SDP is underway) and squash clubs have been accredited through the England Squash Club Charter.</p> <p>Year 1 priority counties: Cambridgeshire, Cornwall, Devon, Essex, Hampshire, Lancashire, Nottinghamshire, Somerset, Staffordshire, Suffolk, Sussex, Warwickshire, West Yorkshire,</p>
