<p>NGB deployment focus for the Community Sports Coaches, linked to the NGB player pathway and relevant development initiatives.</p>	<p>All Community Sports Coach delivered activity should preferably be linked to a PremierClub – the ETTA national programme for club development (aligned with Clubmark). By implication, all clubs will have at least one school link.</p> <p>ETTA are focussing their PESSCL school club links plan on the employment of Community Table Tennis Coaches and expect to have partnership funding available to employ local coaches.</p> <p>Young people targeted will be at PremierClub Introduction, Participation level or below and will take part in ETTA skills and junior umpire awards. Other playing opportunities include competition ladder, junior league, National Cadet league and competitions organised by English Schools' Table Tennis Association.</p>
<p>Minimum level of NGB coaching qualification for coaches employed through the Community Sports Coach Scheme</p>	<p>ETTA Level 2 with previous coaching experience. Able to give effective demonstrations of basic shots.</p> <p>Table Tennis is working in partnership at national level with squash and badminton to create 'Racket Sports' coaches. Where this is successful, the level of qualification will be flexible.</p>
