Regarding Club Development

The CSP has produced an on line club directory, which is featured on its website. This directory however needs enhancing and we are exploring if we have the web based technology to be able to do this. In addition 6 out of 9 local authorities produce a club directory. In 2007 / 08 – 7 out of 9 Local Sport Alliances (CSNs) organised club and coaches seminars. There is an expectation that this work will feature in their 08/09 action plans. The CSP produces a club and coach education programme. This will be published in July 2008. The CSP also has a comprehensive list of clubs that have achieved CLUBMARK or equivalent

Regarding Local Sports Alliances (or CSNs)

The Sports Development Manager (Community) has the overall remit for developing LSAs. Additionally there is a Link Officer system, whereby staff from the CSP’s Core Service Team offer support to individual LSAs. Each officer is committed to attending the “main” meeting of their LSA. In terms of increasing participation of the 16+ age group by 1%, the CSP’s key objectives are:

1. Manage the existing Active Together programme – a unique resource which has put in place 11 Physical Activity Coordinators (PACs), with specific participation targets, charged with working with local communities and partners to get more people involved in sport and physical activity. There is a real opportunities for NGBs to engage with these officers, who are looking to work with quality adult clubs to ensure sustainable participation. This is work happening in Leicestershire county.
2. The CSP has recently submitted CIF applications to fund similar work in Leicester City and Rutland LSAs.
3. Continue to take a responsibility for delivering quality coach and sport education programmes

Additionally:

- We would like to work with NGBs to produce short sports specific action plans for each of our LSAs, potentially extrapolating relevant sections from each NGBs county development plans
- The CSP also works with its SSPs to deliver the Step into Sport Conference and oversee volunteer placements and training. We would welcome information regarding volunteer placements from NGBs
- The CSP has appointed KKP to develop a sub regional facilities strategy. KKP will consult NGBs directly during the next few weeks (from April 2008)
- There is a still an opportunity to bid for Extending Activity resources. This process will be announced at the next county NGB Forum on 16 April.
- There will a partnership review of the Youth Games in September 2008.
