- WPDT invited by Sport England to create a CSN due to:
 1. track record of the Wayland Rural Sports Programme
 2. already funded by Sport England
 3. absence of LA SDO to create CSN by April deadline
 4. Geographically makes sense.
- Need to identify targets associated with Parkwood and PFI implications
- Sports Foundation to help gifted and talented youth
- Sporting Champion to identify with CSN or Olympic star of the future??
- CSN will:
 1. avoid duplication
 2. reduce number of meetings
 3. include a wider range of partners
 4. help avoid tunnel vision
 5. enable more funding to be identified
 6. enable funding to reach grass roots level
 7. ensure that local needs are identified and met
 8. ensure that local plans form part of the CSP plans
 9. provide support for all members
- Need for an Activity survey and audit of clubs, coaches and facilities
- Local area agreements
- Breckland cultural strategy
- Initial funding of £3000 to be used for initial meetings, a formal launch, initial marketing and a consultation
- Need to identify clear vision for CSN
- Need to name, brand, and market network
- Identify other local, county, regional and national strategies that will influence partners within the group e.g. health strategy, community safety strategy etc.
- Consider the future needs and support of the Network
