

CAMBRIDGE CSN PLANNING SESSION (Joint planning with Peterborough-many findings generic across both areas)

ACTION POINTS

- Parts already in process – this is an opportunity to review and formalise work
- Need to investigate a formal link with the Local Strategic Partnership
- Need to work closely with other emerging local authority CSNs in the county to learn and share experiences
- Potential to use this work to reshape / refocus the existing Community Sport Forum that has been in place for a while
- Need to link existing work being developed around Active England project in the city
- Potential to approach South Cambs and discuss a joint South Cambs / City CSN – there is a precedent through the work of the cross border Disability Sport Forum. The city is predominantly urban as well with potential to envelope S Cambs given its rural focus
- Strong need to focus on local demographics, building on the excellent work already undertaken by the Sports Development team – BME/Ageing/Disability etc...
- Opportunities to use this work to create a brand for community sport from this work

Role Of The Local Authority

- Important in achieving PSA targets
- Important to demonstrate leadership but not necessarily chairing and control
- Important to involve the voluntary sector
- Important to investigate engaging the private sector
- Good opportunity to pool resources through this process
