<p><u>Active Lives Survey:</u></p> <p>Taking part in Sport The overall percentage and number of the adult population in England participating in the equivalent of 30 minutes' activity at least twice in 28 days. Each session must last at least 10 minutes and be of at least moderate intensity.</p> <p>Physical Activity The percentage of the adult population who, over the course of a week, does not achieve a total of 30 moderate intensity equivalent (MIE) minutes of physical activity.
